

ORDINANCE NO. 777

An Ordinance revoking and setting aside the dedication of certain streets laid out and dedicated to public use within the corporate limits of City of Slidell, Louisiana, as being no longer needed for public purposes.

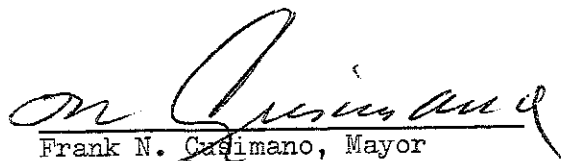
BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

Section 1. The following streets, laid out and dedicated to public use within the corporate limits of City of Slidell, Louisiana, are no longer needed for public purposes, and the dedication of such streets is hereby revoked and set aside, to-wit:

- a. Fairbanks Street, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Sixth Street.
- b. Dewey Avenue, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Eighth Street.
- c. Brakefield Street, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Sixth Street, and from the East right-of-way line of Seventh Street to a point sixty (60) feet East fronting lots 13 and 14, Square 25, and lots 11 and 12, Square 26.
- d. Sixth Street, from the North right-of-way line of Brakefield Street to the South right-of-way line of Fairbanks Street.
- e. Seventh Street, from the North right-of-way line of Schley Street, to the South right-of-way line of Fairbanks Street.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 774, introduced and adopted the 10th day of January, 1967, be hereby repealed.
