

ORDINANCE NO. 778

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, Enlarging the Boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, to Include Lot 1, Square 2, West Hall Park Subdivision.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of January 10th, 1967, a petition from Mr. and Mrs. Otto Yeates, owners of Lot 1, Square 2, West Hall Park Subdivision, requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries to include that lot, and;

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioners are the sole owners of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held March 6th, 1967, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times, under the dates of February 23rd, and March 2nd, 1967. That said hearing was held on the said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION I. NOW THERE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit

Beginning at a corner common to Sections 4, 9, and 38, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, Greensburg District, Louisiana, and run East along the South boundary of Section 4, 656.4 feet to an iron stob and the point of beginning.

Thence go North 100 feet to a point, thence East 135 feet, to a point, then South 100 feet to a point, thence West 135 feet to the point of beginning. This being designated as Lot 1, Square 2, West Hall Park Subdivision, as found on a plat of survey by Lamar P. Harrison, C.E., dated April 14th, 1965.

SECTION II. THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all the property as above described shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
