

ORDINANCE NO. 792

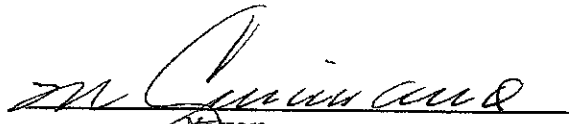
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE STATIONERY OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session, convened, that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana be amended by adding to Chapter 2 - Administration, in Article 1, a new Sec. 2-7, to read as follows:

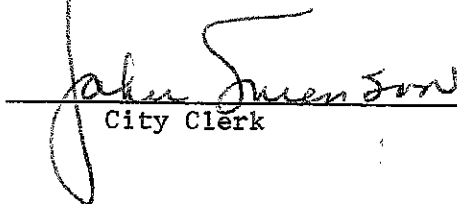
Sec. 2-7. Use of City Stationary

It shall be unlawful for any elected official, or any agent or employee of this city, or any person whosoever, to use the official stationery of the City for the purpose of endorsing a candidate for public office, or to use such stationery in a manner to indicate or give the impression that the governing authority is endorsing such a candidate as a body.
