ORDINANCE NO. 808

Forest Manor
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An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the Boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of March 11th, 1969, a petition from Louis F. Miramon, requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries to include that property, and;

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioners are the sole owners of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held April 8th, 1969, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell - St. Tammany Times, under the dates of March 20th, 27th and April 3rd, 1969, that said hearing was held on the said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION I. NOW THERE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From the corner Common to Sections 1 and 2, T9S, R14E, and Sections 35 and 36, T8S, R14E, go North $89^{\circ} 51'$ West 1085.50' to the point of beginning, thence go North $89^{\circ} 51'$ West 234.50', thence go North $00^{\circ} 04'$ East 1344.08', thence go North $89^{\circ} 53'$ East 525.78', thence go South $00^{\circ} 05'$ West 1271.00', thence go South $68^{\circ} 40'$ West 205.00' to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all the property as above described shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
