

MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING - CITY COUNCIL
September 29th, 1981
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council, Joe Martinez. All members were present with the exception of Councilmen Caruso, Washington, Martin and Singletary. Mayor Hart was absent.

President Martinez stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and receive public input on a one-way street system on Olde Towne, after which he opened the floor for public discussion.

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The following businessmen of Olde Towne were present to speak in opposition to the one-way street system: Mr. Joe Johnson, Slidell Cleaners; Mr. John Krolak, Slidell Bicycle Shop; Mr. Floyd Fogg, Floyd Fogg Insurance; Mr. Stanley Buckley, Giordano and Buckely's Shoes; Mrs. Ethel R. Mire, J.A. Mire Hardware; Mrs. Jane Dunnaway, Dunnaway's Meat Market; Mr. Norman Diette, J R's Place and The Patio; and Mr. Keith Faciane, representing First Bank. Mr. Jack Stroupe, representing Artique Frame Shop, spoke in favor of one-way streets provided they were properly marked and enforced. Mr. Stanley Samrow, Stanley's Electronics, stated the one-way street system should be further studied. As no one else indicated a desire to address the issue, discussion was returned to the Council. Council members stated they wanted to work with the Olde Towne merchants and do whatever they wished regarding the matter. After discussion, it was moved by Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilwoman Gallinghouse Hoppe, that the one-way street system proposals for Olde Towne be tabled indefinitely.
