

ORDINANCE NO. 811

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the Boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of May 13th, 1969, a petition from the St. Tammany Parish School Board, requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries to include that property listed below and;

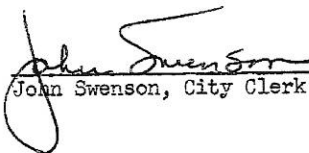
WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner was the sole owner of the following described property, and did give notice of a public hearing on said petition on June 9th, 1969, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times, under the dates of May 21st and 28th, and June 4th, 1969, and said hearing was held on said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition:

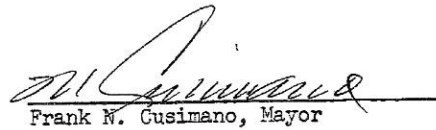
SECTION I. NOW THERE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

Commencing at the corner common to Sections 16, 15, 21 and 22 of Township 9 South, Range 14 East go South 66 degrees 1 minute West 321.0 feet to a point; thence South 63 degrees 23 minutes East 1,822.15 feet to a point; thence South 463.0 feet to the point of beginning. From the point of beginning continue South 60.43 feet; thence go North 89 degrees 30 minutes East 84.96 feet to a point; thence go South 26 degrees 37 minutes West 1,166.41 feet to a point; thence go North 63 degrees 27 minutes West 309.00 feet to a point; thence go North 26 degrees 37 minutes East 905.28 feet to a point; thence go North 63 degrees 23 minutes West 29.10 feet to a point; thence go North 50 degrees 55 minutes East 182.0 feet to a point; thence go North 65 degrees 41 minutes East 72.50 feet to a point; thence go South 88 degrees 43 minutes East 127.00 feet back to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land contains 8.00 acres.

SECTION II. THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all the property as above described shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
