

ORDINANCE NO. 816

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of June 10, 1969, a petition from Harold G. Duplechein, Lloyd P. Guillot, D.V.M., James S. Holmes, M.D. requesting the enlargement of the city boundaries to include that property, and;

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioners are the sole owners of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held on August 12, 1969, at the City Hall, by publication in the SLIDELL-ST. TAMMANY TIMES, under the dates of July 17, 21, 31 and August 8, 1969, that said hearing has held on the said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION I. NOW THERE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From a point common with sections 2, 3, 10, and 11, go north 2353.2 feet following the section line between sections 2 and 3 to the point of beginning. Thence continue north 730 feet, thence west 803 feet, thence south 730 feet, thence east 803 feet to the point of beginning, containing $13\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

SECTION II. THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all the property as above described shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
