

MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 8th, 1982
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Lionel J. Washington, President of the Council. All Council Members were present. Mayor Hart was absent.

Councilwoman Wood requested Item No. 4a, Certificate of Appreciation, be removed from the Consent Calendar and placed as Agenda Item No. 1 after which Councilman Singletary, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy, moved the adoption of the following Consent Calendar as amended:

On behalf of the City Council, Councilwoman Wood presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Larry Groce, 1982 Affiliate Artist Residency performer.

Reinhard Dearing, Council Administrator, opened bids for the official journal for the City for Fiscal Year 1982-83 and the following bids were received:

After discussion, the President deferred action on acceptance of the bids until later in the meeting in order that the City Attorney and the Council Administrator could review the bids.

As there was nothing to report on the 201 Sewerage Project, it was moved by Councilman Barthelemy, seconded by Councilwoman Gallinghouse Hoppe, that the 201 Project be tabled until the June 22nd, 1982 meeting.

Councilwoman Wood requested action on tabled Item No. 82-4-441, an amendment to the City's Central Purchasing Ordinance, be deferred until after the public hearing was held on Item No. 82-5-446. With no objections, the President so declared.

Councilman Hinton provided background information on tabled Item No. 82-2-427, a proposed ordinance amending the 1981-82 Operating Budget to fund a portion of the expenses of the St. Tammany Economic Development Foundation. Councilman Hinton, seconded by Councilman Martinez, moved to take the proposed ordinance off the table.

Several citizens spoke both in favor of and in opposition to the proposed ordinance. After discussion, Councilman Hinton, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy, moved the adoption of Ordinance No. 1510 (Item No. 82-2-427).

As advertised, a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 82-5-446, a proposed ordinance amending the City's Central Purchasing Ordinance. Councilwoman Wood explained the proposed ordinance would eliminate Section 2-10 from the City's Code of Ordinances and the city would then fall under State law regarding purchasing. Several citizens spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance and as no one else indicated a desire to be heard, the public hearing was closed. Councilwoman Wood, seconded by Councilman Hinton, moved to table the proposed ordinance until the June 22nd, 1982 meeting in order that an amendment could be prepared before adoption.

As advertised, a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 82-5-447, a proposed ordinance annexing and zoning 4.86 acres as petitioned by Mr. Riley Lee representing the Calvary Baptist Church. Mr. Lee spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance and as no one else indicated a desire to be heard, the public hearing was closed. Councilman Singletary, seconded by Councilmen Caruso and Hinton, moved the adoption of Ordinance No. 1511.

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As advertised, a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 82-5-448, a proposed ordinance rezoning Lots 17, 18, 19, and 20, Square 10, Northside Subdivision. Mr. T. A. Sherlock, petitioner, spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance and as no one else indicated a desire to be heard, the public hearing was closed. Councilman Caruso, seconded by Councilwoman Gallinghouse Hoppe, moved the adoption of Ordinance No. 1512.

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Councilman Hinton, seconded by Councilman Singletary, moved to reject all bids for the official journal for Fiscal Year 1982-83 and readvertise with bids to be opened at the June 22nd, 1982 council meeting. After discussion, Councilman Hinton withdrew his motion. It was then moved by Councilman Barthelemy, seconded by Councilman Hinton, that the Council select the official journal by placing it out for bids again and the lowest bid received would be awarded the official journal and in the event tie bids are received, the first bid received would be awarded the official journal, with the Council Administrator and the City Attorney certifying the low bid received.

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It was moved by Councilman Martinez, seconded by Councilman Singletary, that the Administration and the Finance Director, in cooperation with the City Consulting Engineer and the City Planning Director, prepare an objective presentation for the June 22nd Council meeting regarding the Chamale' Cove annexation in order for the Council to review the matter.

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The City Attorney addressed the Council regarding a right-of-way acquisition in connection with the 201 Sewerage Project. After discussion, it was moved by Councilwoman Gallinghouse Hoppe, seconded by Councilwoman Wood, acting on the advice of the City Attorney and the City Consulting Engineer, that the price of \$4,964.00 was acceptable for a piece of property measuring 21x18x25, owned by Carol Ann Brown Pieri, which was needed for the 201 Sewerage Project.
