

ORDINANCE NO. 827

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of fifty (.50) one hundredths mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the Town Hall Bonds of the City of Slidell, for the year 1970.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of fifty (.50) one hundredths mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1969.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Town Hall Bonds for the City of Slidell for the year 1970, as duly authorized by a resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 27th of January, 1953.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage.
