

MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 10th, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Lionel J. Washington. All Council Members and Mayor Hart were present.

Before the Consent Calendar, Lionel J. Washington, President of the Council, introduced Boy Scout Troop 111 from Slidell. The boy scouts are working on citizenship for a merit badge and they must attend a Council meeting to observe government in the City of Slidell.

24 St. Tammany Parish Council, addressed the Council.

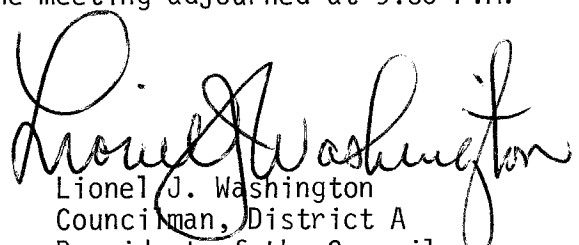
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26 It was moved by Councilman Martinez, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt
