

MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 26th, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip M. Salvaggio. All Council Members and Mayor Hart were present with the exception of Councilmen Callahan and Barthelemy and Councilwoman Williams.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Washington moved for the adoption of the following Consent Calendar:

As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 83-6-605 (an ordinance naming U.S. Highway 190 West within the City Limits). Larry Ciko, 1631 Eleventh Street questioned the use of the word Boulevard. As no one else from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Washington moved for the adoption of an amendment to Item No. 83-6-605.

As advertised, a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 83-6-606(An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of same). As no one from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Washington moved that based on the recommendation of the City Attorney the Council adopt ordinance No. 1642.

ROLL CALL 7 Yeas 0 Nays 2 Absent CARRIED

As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Item No. 83-6-607 (Rezoning from A-7 to C-3 (Eddy Daniels). Barry Brupbacher, Director of Planning and Permits stated that with this classification of zoning no off street parking spaces were required. The Council noted that there was a letter permitting parking for this business in Coopers Automotive on Sgt. Alfred Drive. As no one else from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1643 on the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

As no one from the public desired to be heard, the public hearings were closed.
