

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 9th, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip M. Salvaggio. All Council Members and Mayor Hart were present with the exception of Councilman Berault and Councilman At Large Martinez.

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Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Washington moved to Suspend the Rules to have the Public Hearing on the Notice of Intention (1) Subsurface Drainage (2) Sewerage System and (3) Water Works System moved up.

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As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Notice of Intention (1) Subsurface Drainage, (2) Sewerage System and (3) Water Works System. Fred Barrard, Rt. 5, Slidell, Louisiana requested tha the work be done on South Maple Street. As no one else from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman Barthelemy, seconded by Councilman Washington moved to delete all streets on the Resolutions with the exception of South Maple Street from its intersection with Louis Street to its intersection with Terrace Avenue.

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Jack Boyd, Director of Sewer and Water, advised the Council that sealed bids were opened on August 1, 1983 at 10 am in the presence of Virginia Roe, Billie Spiers, Gerri Ingrao and himself for a backhoe. The following bids were received:

Furlow-Laughlin Equipment Inc.	\$26,100.00

Jack Boyd then stated that the company of Furlow-Laughlin Equipment Inc. had sent in two bids and that the second was left off of the letter. The first bid in the amount of \$26,100.00 did not meet specifications the second bid in the amount of \$29,400.00 did meet all specifications and was the low bid. Therefore the administration recommends the low bid from Furlow-Laughlin Equipment Incorporated in the amount of \$29,400.00 for a backhoe.

It was moved by Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Washington that the Council accept the low bid from Furlow-Laughlin Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$29,400.00 on the recommendation of the administration.

Mayor Hart announced that he is looking for a firm that would be able to tell the Administration just what is causing the "black water" in Slidell and how, if possible, to go about alleviating this problem.

The report on Operation Rainwater was deferred until the next meeting which will be August 23, 1983.

It was requested that Council Administrator, Reinhard Dearing, set up guidelines for the use of the Council Chambers and bring them back before the Council for ratification.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy moved to accept the Resolution rejecting all bids accepted at the last council meeting for New Major Wastewater Transmission Line - 201 Project - Slidell Louisiana - E.P.A. Project No. C-220386-11 C & A Job No. 7908-4 due to the fact that all state bid laws had not been complied with.

Moved by Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Callahan for the amendment to the Resolution, Page 1, Line 47.
