

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 23rd, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip M. Salvaggio. All Council Members and Mayor Hart were present.

Councilman At Large Singletary, requested withdrawal of Item 3b (Proposed Resolutions: Slidell Memorial Hospital) from the Consent Calendar and substituted it with another Resolution adding sidewalks.

Councilman At Large Martinez, requested withdrawal of Item 3c (Proposed Resolutions: Parish Ordinance #83-462) from the Consent Calendar.

Councilman At Large Martinez, seconded by Councilman Berault moved to adopt the following Consent Calendar as amended.

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Item 3c (Proposed Resolutions: Parish Ordinance #83-642 - \$25.00 Service Charge) removed from the Consent Calendar was brought before the Council.

Following a discussion Councilman At Large Martinez, seconded by Councilman At Large Singletary moved to have the City Attorney file a legal memorandum along with the suit already in progress filed by the Parish Assessor, Wayne Wascom.

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As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Item Number 83-7-610 (an ordinance abandoning the last one hundred and twenty (120) feet of Oleander Street). Elaine Guillot, City Attorney, stated that she received a phone call from Richard Knight, an attorney in Bogalusa, representing the Schnieder family and he requested the council be informed that the Schnieder's were opposed to this action. As no one else from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy moved to table this item until September 13, 1983.

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As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Item Number 83-7-611 (an ordinance amending Appendix D, Subdivisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell). As no one from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1646.

As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with Item Number 83-7-612 (an ordinance accepting donation of a certain parcel of land). As no one from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Following a discussion among the Council, the City Attorney was requested to find out the owner of the 1/4 parcel left and then Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilman At Large Singletary moved to table this item until the September 13, 1983 meeting.

Roy Cartier, Cartier and Associates, addressed the Council with a Change Order for the 201 Sewerage Improvement Project. After discussion among the Council, Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt moved that based on the recommendation of the Consulting Engineer and the administration the Council should accept the change order #4 in the amount of \$2,502.34.

Roy Cartier, Cartier and Associates, then discussed "Operation Rainwater" with the Council and the Mayor.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy moved that no modification of the Operation Rainwater Project be done at all as presented to the voters on November 4, 1980 without the majority vote of this Council. Also that the leaflet from that election be made a part of these minutes.

Following further discussion, Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt moved that the Consulting Engineer, Roy Cartier, has the approval of this Council to change Item #6 Brakefield Street to Stanley Street Culverts.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Berault moved to table this item until September 13th, 1983.

At this time, the Chamber of Commerce came before the Council requesting a special function liquor/beer permit for the Slidell Trade Fair, to be held on September 24 and 25.

Councilwoman Williams, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt moved to grant the special liquor/beer permit to the Slidell Chamber of Commerce for their Trade Fair to be held in the City Auditorium, City Park and premises.

Old Towne One Way System was brought before the Council since the 90 day trial period was over. Mr. Stanley Samrow, 340 Brakefield, spoke in behalf of himself and the Olde Towne Merchants Association stated that they were in favor of the one way continuing as it is now. They request installation of a light at Cousin and Third Streets. The Traffic Engineer was requested to look into this possibility. Mr. Dave Anderson, First Bank, spoke stating that there is a problem with persons leaving the bank and he has noted no police action taken. As no one else from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman At Large Martinez, seconded by Councilman Berault moved that the Police Department monitor this situation for the next two (2) weeks and give a report as to any traffic going against this one way. Also to have

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an additional one way sign installed at the corner of Front and Cousin Street.

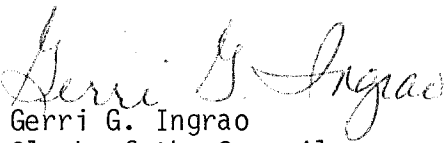
ROLL CALL 9 Yeas 0 Nays 0 Absent CARRIED
