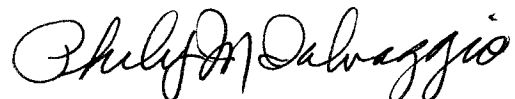
Elaine Guillot, City Attorney, stated to the Council that on August 9th, 1983 the Council passed a Resolution rescinding the acceptance of the low bid from Clement Betpouey, Jr. & Co. for the 201 Major Transmission Line EPA #C-220386-11 C & A Job # 7908-4. Based on the Attorney General's Opinion these bids need to be rejected and the job needs to be readvertised.

Councilman Van Sandt seconded by Councilman Berault moved that on the advice of the City Attorney and the opinion of the Attorney General all bids received on the 201 Major Transmission Line EPA Job # C-220386-11, C & A Job # 7908-4 be rejected due to the lack of compliance to R.S. 38:2212 and to go back out for bid as soon as possible.

It is requested that the opinion from the Attorney General and the opinion from the City Attorney be made a part of these minutes.
