

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 27th, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip M. Salvaggio. All Council Members and Mayor Hart were present.

Councilman Barthelemy, seconded by Councilman Washington moved to Suspend the Rules to introduce two additional ordinances onto the Consent Calendar.

ROLL CALL 9 Yeas 0 Nays 0 Absent CARRIED

Councilman At Large Martinez requested removal of Item 3b (Proposed Resolution: St. Tammany Parish Library Board of Control) from the Consent Calendar.

Councilman Barthelemy introduced Item Number 83-9-625, an amendment amending Appendix A-Zoning Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell and Ordinance No. 795, a Zoning Ordinance.

Councilman Washington introduced Item Number 83-9-626, an ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of same.

Councilman Van Sandt requested removal of Item 3a (Proposed Resolution: Louisiana Statewide Flood Control Pre-Application) from the Consent Calendar.

Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Berault moved that the following Consent Calendar be adopted as amended.

Item 3b (Proposed Resolution: St. Tammany Parish Library Board of Control) removed from the Consent Calendar was brought before the Council.

Councilman At Large Martinez, introduced Judy Wood who spoke representing the St. Tammany Parish Library Board of Control for the passage of this Resolution and what it would mean to the citizens of Slidell.

Councilman At Large Martinez, seconded by Councilman Berault moved to adopt the substitute Resolution with the correct millage.

Council President Salvaggio wished to qualify his vote with the following statement:

"Mrs. Wood I am very much in favor of what the Library Board has done and what it is doing and I will personally vote for this millage increase, but I do not want to recommend another raise. And I am going to vote for this Resolution with that stipulation, because I personally like it."

Item 3a (Proposed Resolution: Louisiana Statewide Flood Control Pre-Application) removed from the Consent Calendar was brought before the Council.

Following a discussion, Councilman Callahan, seconded by Councilman At Large Singletary, moved for the adoption of this Resolution.

Tabled item 83-7-610, (an ordinance abandoning the last one hundred and twenty (120) feet of Oleander Street) (Salvaggio/Van Sandt) was brought before the Council.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy moved to table this item indefinitely.

Tabled Item 83-7-612 (an ordinance accepting a donation of a certain parcel of land) (Salvaggio/Callahan) was to remain tabled until the October 11, 1983 meeting.

At this time the Auditors presented to the Council and the Administration the Audit Report.

Councilman Callahan, seconded by Councilman At Large Martinez moved to have a special meeting to discuss this report on October 18, 1983 at 6:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers.

Tully Rhodes, City Engineer, spoke regarding the change order #3 for the 201 Sewerage Improvement Project.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilwoman Williams moved to accept this change order.

ROLL CALL 9 Yeas 0 Nays 0 Absent CARRIED

Councilman At Large Martinez left the meeting at 7:40 P.M.

Roy Cartier, Cartier and Associates, spoke regarding the tabled item #6 on Operation Rainwater. Following a discussion among the Council, Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt moved that based on the recommendation of the City Engineer and the Consulting Engineer that we substitute the Brakefield Project with the Stanley Street Project in Operation Rainwater and that we recommend that the Mayor have the public works department clean all major drainage ditches in Park Place Subdivision.

ROLL CALL 8 Yeas 0 Nays 1 Absent CARRIED

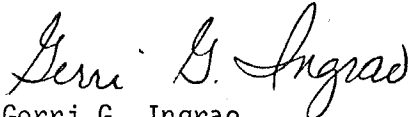
The Slidell Newcomers Association came before the Council with a request for a Special Function Liquor/Beer Permit.
