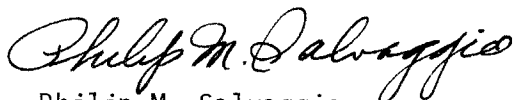
Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Barthelemey moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1654.

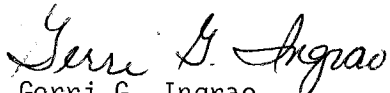
ROLL CALL	8 Yeas	0 Nay	1 Absent	CARRIED
