

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 13th, 1983
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip M. Salvaggio. All Council Members were present with the exception of Councilman At Large Martinez and Councilman Washington. Mayor Hart was also absent.

As advertised a public hearing was held in connection with item number 83-11-635, BAA - Board of Adjustment and Appeals. As no one from the public desired to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Following a discussion among the Council, Councilman At Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Berault moved to table this item indefinitely.

It was moved by Councilman Callahan, seconded by Councilman Washington to have Mr. James L. Stamy appointed to the BZA as an alternate member.
