Councilman Salvaggio was unanimously elected President.

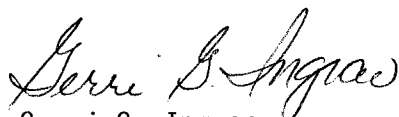
Councilman Berault, seconded by Councilwoman Williams moved to nominate Councilman Van Sandt for Vice President of the Council.

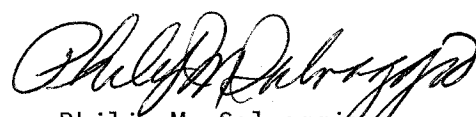
Councilman At Large Singletary moved to close the nominations.
