

ORDINANCE NO. 837

The following ordinance was offered by Mr. Pichon
and seconded by Mr. Abney:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SLIDELL,
LOUISIANA TO SELL REAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED
FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of
Slidell, Louisiana in Legal Session Convened:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property is not
needed for public purposes and the City of Slidell, Louisiana must obtain funds
to pay the indebtedness incurred under Local or Special Assessment Ordinance
No. 1-A of 1964 Sewerage District No. 1-A of the City of Slidell, Louisiana and
Local or Special Assessment Ordinance No. 1 of 1966 - Paving.

SECTION 2. That the City of Slidell, Louisiana through its Mayor
is hereby authorized to sell at private sale without any warranty, whatsoever, of
any nature or description, even for the return of the purchase price but with full
substitution in and to all rights and actions of warranty which it may have against
all preceding owners or vendors whomsoever on the terms of cash payable at the
time of the sale with all costs of the sale to be paid by the purchaser for the
minimum price of NINE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$950.00) DOLLARS, the
following described property, to-wit:

ALL THOSE CERTAIN LOTS OR PARCELS OF GROUND, toge-
ther with all buildings and improvements thereon, situated in
the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana,
in that subdivision known as LINCOLN PARK, and designated
as follows:

Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11, Sq. 9 Lincoln Park Subdivision.

Being the same property acquired by City of Slidell, Louisiana,
per Sheriff's Deed from Will F. Brent, et al, in the matter of
City of Slidell, La. vs. Will F. Brent, et al, Suit No. 31,247,
and recorded in COB 564 folio 344, records of St. Tammany
Parish, Louisiana.

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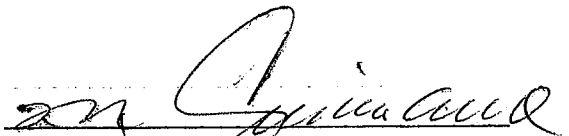
This ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon
was as follows:

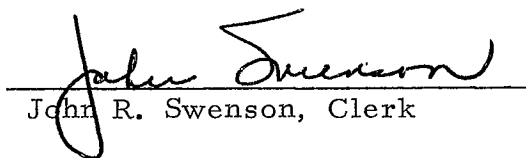
