SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 20, 1984

1 The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Philip
2 M. Salvaggio. All Council Members were present. Mayor Hart was absent.

5 to Suspend the Rules to have the public hearing on the Widening of Fremaux Avenue
6 and the Interchange at I-10 moved up.

17 of Fremaux Avenue and the Interchange at I-10. Ms. Charlene Fraizer, 704 Fremaux
18 Avenue presented a petition of 200 signatures to the Council showing support
19 of the 4 lanes for Fremaux Avenue. Mrs. Nettie McManus, 417 Fremaux Avenue spoke
20 in opposition to the widening to four lanes. Bob Edens spoke regarding the
21 land to be taken from his property. Mr. Ray Sparando spoke in favor of the
22 widening. Mr. Woody Ashcraft spoke in favor of the widening. Mr. Royce McManus,
23 417 Fremaux Avenue spoke requesting sidewalks when the widening is completed.
24 A general discussion took place during this time with the Council and the
25 audience. As no one else from the public spoke, the public hearing was closed.
