ORDINANCE NO. 1746

PURCHASE OF SHERMAN PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell that the

for the sum of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) all cash, in accordance
with a purchase agreement to be signed by all parties, and that the Honorable M.W.
"Webb" Hart, Mayor, be and he is hereby authorized to sign any and all necessary
documents in order to carry out the proper and complete acquisition of the following
described property, to wit:

Lot one (1) of Square Fifteen (15) of the Robert Addition. Said
lot has a frontage of 60 feet between parallel lines and is on the
Southwest corner of the intersection of Bouscaren Street and
Fourth Street.

Said Square is bounded on the North by Bouscaren Street, on the East
by Fourth Street, on the South by Cousin Street, and the West by
Third Street.
