3 the exception of Councilman Washington.

6 No. 84-10-764, granting an increase in salary to the Chief of Police) to be
7 removed from the Consent Calendar.
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9 Councilman Berault, seconded by Councilman Van Sandt, moved to
10 Suspend the Rules to add a Resolution to the Consent Calendar.

46 Washington moved to substitute Item 84-10-766, Granting an increase in

23 for Change Order #3 Contract C, Fritchie Park.

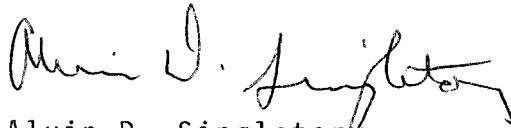
24 Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Washington moved for
