

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
November 13, 1984
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Alvin D. Singletary. All Council Members were present.

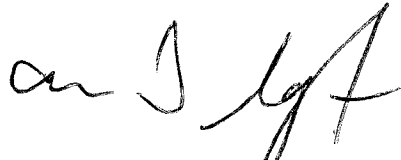
Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Salvaggio, moved to accept Project #201-8, Change Order #2 on the recommendation by the Mayor.

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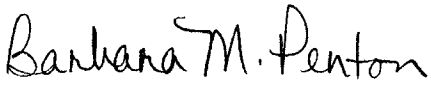
Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy, moved to accept Change Order #3 on the recommendation of the City Engineer.
