

ORDINANCE NO. 841

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging its boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the Governing Body of said Municipality, did receive a petition from Charles Silva, Jr., Conrad Robichaux, Rufus Naquin and Sam Marcello, requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries to include the following described property, and,

WHEREAS, the said Governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioners were the sole owners of said property, and did give notice of said petition by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times, under the dates of June 18th-25th, 1970, and July 2nd-9th, 1970, and no one requested a public hearing, nor objected to said petition.

SECTION I NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From a point South 00 degrees 46 minutes 50 seconds East, 44.93 feet, North 89 degrees 13 minutes 10 seconds East, 150.0 feet, South 00 degrees 46 minutes 50 seconds East, 44.09 feet, North 89 degrees 08 minutes 07 seconds East, 180.0 feet, South 00 degrees 46 minutes 50 seconds East, 54.0 feet, North 89 degrees 08 minutes 07 seconds East 210.0 feet from the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana; go North 89 degrees 08 minutes 07 seconds East 541.59 feet, thence South 40 degrees 47 minutes 46 seconds East 128.3 feet, thence South 09 degrees 10 minutes 07 seconds West 38.2 feet, thence South 89 degrees 08 minutes 07 seconds West 617.29 feet, thence North 00 degrees 46 minutes 50 seconds West 136.0 feet to the point of beginning, as described on plot of survey No. 70-1631, dated February 18th, 1970, by Gerald Fussell, No. 7982, Land Engineering Service, Covington, Louisiana, and identified as Lots 17 A, 17 B, 17 C, 18 A, 18 B and 18 C.

SECTION II THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all the above described property shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
