

ORDINANCE NO. 842

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging its boundaries by 23.580 acres.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said Municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. Peter D. Pravata, Erlanger Social Club, Kaycee Club, St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1, Veterans Club of Slidell and Slidell Little Theatre, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries to include the following described property, and,

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that the said petitioners were the sole owners of the petitioned property, and did give notice of said petition by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times under the dates of July 23rd-30th, 1970, and August 6th, 1970, and no one requested a public hearing nor objected to said petition.

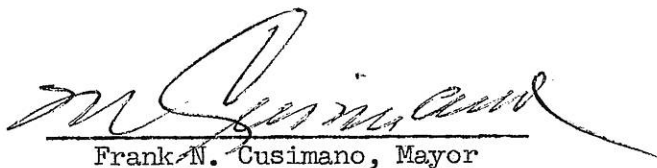
SECTION I NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include all those certain lots or parcels of land, lying and being situated in Lots 1 and 2, Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, Ninth Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows, to-wit:

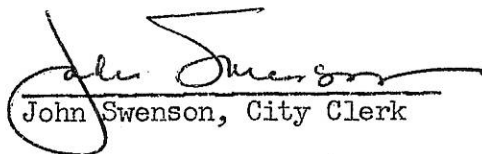
Parcel 1 - From the quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 9, of said Township and Range, go West a distance of 345.2 feet, thence North 1111.0 feet, thence North 75 degrees 15 minutes East 268.86 feet to the point of beginning, thence continue North 75 degrees 15 minutes East 42.84 feet, thence go North 00 degrees 45 minutes West a distance of 506.0 feet, thence go South 73 degrees West 36.37 feet, thence go South 506.23 feet to the point of beginning.

Parcel 2 - From the quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 9 of said Township and Range go West a distance of 345.2 feet to the point of beginning, thence continue West 974.8 feet, thence go North 904.3 feet, thence go North 75 degrees 15 minutes East 1010.3 feet, thence go South 1161.0 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property being listed as parcels 1 and 2 of a Plat of Survey by J. V. Burkes. C.E., No. 6997, Survey No. 6648, dated May 25th, 1970.
