The following ordinance was offered by Mr. McDaniel and
seconded by Mr. Hinton.

LOCAL OR SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ORDINANCE NO. 1-D OF
1966 - PAVING

An ordinance amending Local or Special Assessment No. 1 of
1966 - Paving, adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of
the City of Slidell, Louisiana, on April 5, 1966 entitled:

"An ordinance providing for the levying of a local or special
assessment on each lot or parcel of real estate abutting on cer-
tain streets in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in proportion that
the frontage of each lot bears to all of the abutting lots or parcels
of real estate on said streets, to be improved by the construction
of asphalt concrete paving, with suitable base treatment, all in
accordance with the provisions of Title 33, Section 3301, et seq.,
Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell,
Louisiana acting as the governing authority of said City:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Local or Special Assessment Ordinance
No. 1 of 1966 - Paving, adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of
Slidell, Louisiana, on April 5, 1966, and recorded in MOB 280 folio 215, be, and
the same is hereby amended by correcting Assessments Nos. 412 and 413 to read
as follows:

- 412. Fritchie Bros., Inc.
Lot No. 3, Square 2
Lincoln Park Subdivision (West side Clark Avenue)
COB 105, folio 55
258.33 feet - \$1,291.50
- 413. Heirs and Estate of Sam Thornton
Lot No. 2, Square 2
Lincoln Park S/D (Park Avenue - West Side)
COB 329 folio 205
50 feet - \$249.97

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Court and Ex-Officio Recorder of Mortgages
in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, Louisiana, be and he is hereby, empowered,
authorized and directed to correct Assessment Nos. 412 and 413, recorded in MOB

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280 folio 215, to read as hereinabove set forth, and to cancel from his records any lien in contravention to this amendment.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be published in the official journal of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, being an ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

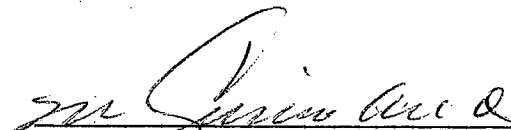

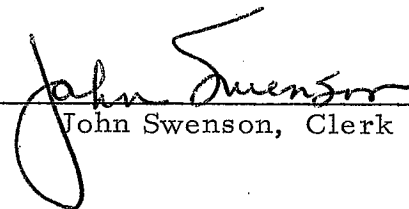
