

ORDINANCE NO. 848

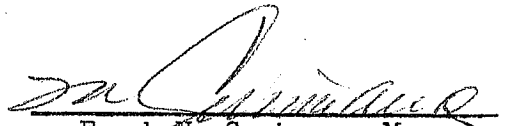
An Ordinance to provide revenue for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the purpose of paying and defraying the general expenses of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the general and local purposes of the year 1971.

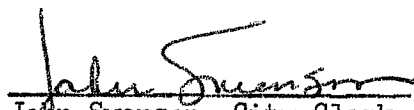
SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that seven (7) mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana which is situated in the corporate limits of the City of Slidell and according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1970, which assessment roll is now on file in the office of the Clerk and Tax Collector of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, to-wit:

Seven (7) mills on the dollar for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenue to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and local purposes of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1971, as shown by the budget for the year 1971 adopted by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage.
