Council President Singletary asked that, for the record, it be noted this proposed resolution was in accord with the agreement worked out between he, the city and the hospital board whereby the hospital will pay for the materials and the city will provide the labor to widen said streets providing a third lane for parking purposes.

Councilman Van Sandt, seconded by Councilman Washington moved the adoption of R85-7.

There followed a discussion among the Council and the administration.

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Councilwoman Williams, seconded by Councilman Callahan made a motion to adopt Item No. 85-1-786 as amended.

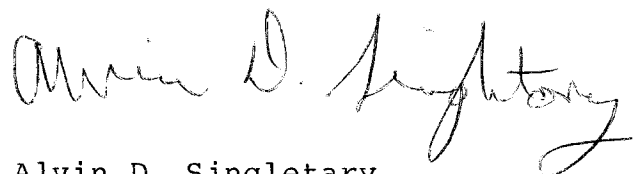
