

MINUTES
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL
March 20, 1985
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Acting President of the Council Richard B. Van Sandt. All members with the exception of Councilman Washington were present.

Councilman Berault, seconded by Councilwoman Williams moved to Suspend the Rules in order to add two proposed ordinances to the Consent Calendar.

Councilman Callahan, seconded by Councilman Barthelemy made a motion to accept the base bid, numbers one (1) through nine (9), alternate 2-A, alternate 3-A and alternate 4-A totaling \$55,388.24 and included acceptance by the Council of a change order for fencing of the ball fields, the total amount of this contract and change order being \$63,022.24. It was also specified that the letter from Burk and Associates, Inc. dated March 18, 1985 be made a part of these minutes upon the recommendation of the administration.
