

ORDINANCE NO. 856

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said Municipality, did receive a petition from the Stone Container Corporation requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries to include the following described property, and;

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of their intention to act on said petition by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times under the dates of December 24th and 31st, 1970, and January 7th, 1971, and no opposition to said petition was received.

SECTION 1. NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain lot or parcel of land, together with all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, advantages and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more particularly described as follows:

From the quarter corner common to Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East and Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, go S 89°48' W 246.69 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue S 89°48' W 602.14 feet to a point located on the right of way of the GM&O Railroad; thence go N 19°54' W 650 feet along the east right of way line of the GM&O Railroad to a point; thence go N 89°48'12" E 823.39 feet to a point; thence go South 611.91 feet to the point of beginning. All in accordance with a plat of survey dated July 11, 1969, by J. V. Burkes, Civil Engineer, containing ten (10) acres.

SECTION II. THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all the property, as above described, shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
