

MINUTES  
SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL  
November 25, 1986  
6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Council, Councilwoman Williams. All Council members were present with the exception of Councilman Callahan and Councilman at Large Martinez.

Councilman Washington, seconded by Councilman Salvaggio moved to Suspend the Rules in order to add Resolutions R86-67 and R86-68 and Item Nos. 86-11-1105 and 86-11-1106 to the Consent Calendar.

After a lengthy informational discussion Councilman at Large Singletary, seconded by Councilman Washington moved to adopt Resolution R86-66.
