

ORDINANCE NO. 863

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Slidell R. I. Corporation, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries to include 5.968 acres; and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioners were the sole owners of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the SLIDELL-ST. TAMMANY TIMES, under date of September 23, 1971, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to wit:

A 3.968 acre tract of land in Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more particularly described as follows:

From the intersection of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, go north 89 degrees 13 minutes 10 seconds east, a distance of 403.66 feet along the north right of way line of Gause Road (Louisiana 1092) to the point of right of way line widening; thence north 00 degrees 42 minutes 59 seconds west a distance of 51.82 feet; thence north 89 degrees 17 minutes 01 seconds east a distance of 327.91 feet along said right of way line widening; thence north 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds east a distance of 143.97 feet to a point of beginning; thence north 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds west a distance of 200 feet; thence south 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 150 feet; thence north 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds west a distance of 220 feet; thence north 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds east a distance of 696.61 feet to the west right of way line of Interstate 10; thence south 24 degrees 10 minutes 07 seconds west a distance of 272 feet; thence south 55 degrees 54 minutes 13 seconds west a distance of 78.9 feet; thence south 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 318.02 feet; thence south 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds east a distance of 135 feet; thence south 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 40 feet to point of beginning.

A 2.00 acre tract of land in Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, described as follows:

From the intersection of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, Township 9 south, Range 14 east, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, go north 89 degrees 13 minutes 10 seconds east a distance of 403.66 feet along the north right

of way line of Gause Road (Louisiana 1092) to point or right of way line widening; thence north 00 degrees 42 minutes 59 seconds west a distance of 51.82 feet; thence north 89 degrees 17 minutes 01 seconds east a distance of 327.91 feet along said right of way line widening; thence north 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds east a distance of 143.97 feet; thence north 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds west a distance of 200 feet; thence south 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 150 feet; thence north 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds west a distance of 220 feet to a point of beginning; thence north 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds west a distance of 171.5 feet; thence north 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds east a distance of 508 feet; thence south 02 degrees 21 minutes 41 seconds east a distance of 171.5 feet; thence south 87 degrees 38 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 508 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
