

ORDINANCE NO. 866

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Leto Packing, Inc., requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries to include 4.676 acres; and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioners were the sole owners of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell - St. Tammany Times, under date of November 4, 1971, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to wit:

THAT CERTAIN PIECE OR PORTION OF GROUND, together with all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, advantages and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more particularly described as follows:

From the quarter corner common to Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, and Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, go South 89 degrees 41' East, a distance of 866.43 feet, thence North 19 degrees 54' West, a distance of 650 feet to the point of beginning located on the right of way line of G. M. & O. Railroad; thence continue North 19 degrees 54' West a distance and fronting on said right of way of 369.81 feet to a point, thence North 82 degrees 18' West a distance of 771.17 feet to a point on a gravel road, thence South a distance of 242.27 feet to a point, thence North 89 degrees 48' East a distance of 638.39 feet to the point of beginning. All in accordance with a plat of survey by J. V. Burkes, C. E., dated November 6th, 1970.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

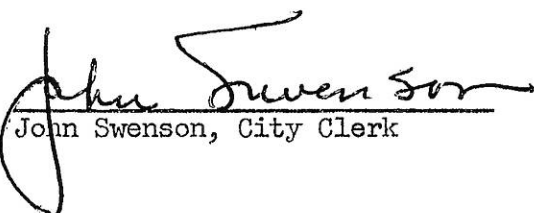
This ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
