

ORDINANCE NO. 878

The following Ordinance was offered by Mr. Hinton and seconded by Mr. McDaniel:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA TO SELL REAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana in Legal Session Convened:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property is not needed for public purposes and that the City of Slidell, Louisiana through its Mayor is hereby authorized to sell at private sale without any warranty, whatsoever, of any nature or description, even for the return of the purchase price but with full substitution in and to all rights and actions of warranty which it may have against all preceding owners or vendors whomsoever on the terms of cash payable at the time of the sale with all costs of the sale to be paid by the purchaser, the following described property, to-wit:

LOTS NOS. 12, 13, and 14, Square 5, Lincoln Park Addition to the Town of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

Said lots each have a frontage of 25 feet on Clark Avenue by a depth of 120 feet between parallel lines. Said Square 5 is bounded North by Stanley Street, East by Harrison Avenue, South by Claude Street and West by Clark Avenue.

MINIMUM PRICE-\$350.00 each

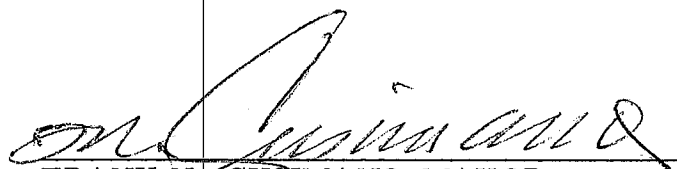
This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

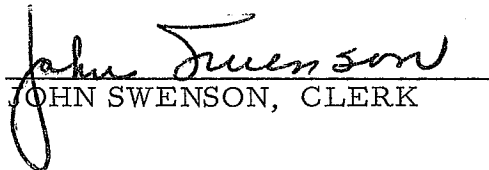
