

MINUTES

NOVEMBER 8, 1988

The meeting was called to order by the President, Councilman Van Sandt. All Council Members were present with the exception of Councilman Berault and Councilman-at-Large Singletary.

3. **Item No. 88-09-1299:** An ordinance annexing and zoning approximately 17.88 acres of land located east of Voter's Road and north of the Ecol Gas Station and Old Spanish Trail, as petitioned by Mr. Angelo A. Paternostro.

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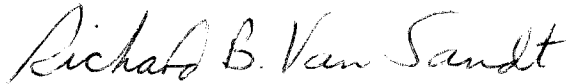
