

ORDINANCE NO. 880

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. Louis G. Miramon, Jr. requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times, April 20th and 27th and May 4th, 1972, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 2, also the point of beginning, go North 89 degrees, 45 minutes West 4252.26 feet to a point; thence go along a drainage canal in two courses, South 00 degree, 53 minutes East 659.65 feet to a point, thence South 38 degrees, 15 minutes East 479.85 feet to a point; thence go South 89 degrees, 56 minutes East 169.5 feet to a point; thence go North 09 degrees, 50 minutes West 152.4 feet to a point; thence go South 89 degrees, 54 minutes East 298.2 feet to a point; thence go South 00 degree, 25 minutes East 150.0 feet to a point; thence go South 89 degrees, 56 minutes East 3502.18 feet to a point; thence go North 1022.5 feet back to the point of beginning.

Said parcel contains 99.023 acres of land.

All in accordance with Survey No. 7636 dated January 11, 1972 by J. V. Burkes, C.E.

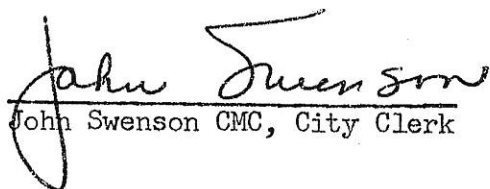
SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

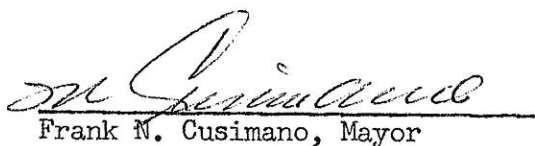
This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
