

ORDINANCE NO. 886

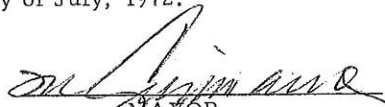
An Ordinance Amending and Re-enacting a Section of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, Relative to Main Floor Levels.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED:

Section 2.301 of Appendix A-Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 2.301: The "F" District is established to require elevation of main floor levels of all buildings to a height of not less than one (1) foot above highest flood levels as recorded since 1921. Along the coast of Lake Pontchartrain this shall mean main floor levels of not less than seven (7) feet above mean sea level in unprotected areas. In any areas shown on the district map as inundation areas, floor levels of all buildings shall be not less than indicated and levels may be amended as necessary by a report of the city engineer based on later information.
