

ORDINANCE NO. 888

An Ordinance Amending and Re-enacting a Section of the City Code, City of Slidell, Louisiana, Relative to the Auditorium.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED.

Chapter Five of the Code of Ordinances of City of Slidell, Louisiana, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Chapter Five: Auditorium

Sec. 5-1. Applicability of regulations.

The regulations contained in this chapter shall govern the use of the City auditorium by other than governmental agencies or subdivisions.

Sec. 5-2. Use to be civic or semi-civic.

The City auditorium shall be used only for activities of a civic or semi-civic nature.

Sec. 5-3. Domicile, citizenship of users.

The City auditorium shall be used only by organizations or groups domiciled in the City or the majority of whose members are citizens of the City.

Sec. 5-4. Users responsible for damages.

Any organization or individuals desiring to use the auditorium shall be responsible, in solido, for any loss or damage to the premises, furniture, fixtures or equipment which may occur during occupancy or use by them or anyone acting in their behalf, regardless of whose fault is the cause and whether or not the party or parties at fault are known or unknown or members of such organization or not, and shall agree to indemnify the City in full for such damage or loss, together with a reasonable attorney fee in the event the claim is placed in the hands of an attorney-at-law for collection or suit. The Mayor and City Council may require a damage deposit if they deem such deposit to be necessary to protect public property.

Sec. 5-5. Application to use required.

All applications for use of the auditorium shall be signed by at least two financially responsible persons and shall be filed with the City Clerk, on application forms to be provided by the Clerk, which forms shall require the applicant to furnish sufficient information to insure that the use of the auditorium shall not conflict with these rules.

Sec. 5-6. Rental fee to accompany application; fee.

The full amount of the rental fee shall be submitted with the application to use the City auditorium. The rental fee shall be established by the Mayor and City Council.

Sec. 5-7. Approval of application.

All applications to use the City auditorium must be approved by the Mayor and at least three (3) City Councilmen, or, in absence of approval by the Mayor, by at least four (4) City Councilmen.

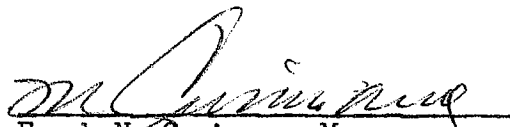
Sec. 5-8. Notice to fire department required.  
Any organization or individuals using the auditorium shall notify the City Fire Department at least one week in advance of use.

Sec. 5-9. Decorations, stage properties to be free standing; tampering with electrical system.

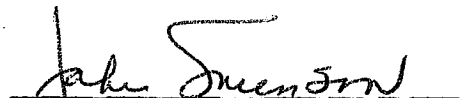
All decorations and stage properties in the City auditorium must be free standing, and nothing shall be attached to or suspended from walls or ceiling, nor shall anyone tie in or tamper with any electrical circuits or equipment.

Sec. 5-10 Violators ineligible for future use.  
Any violation of this chapter shall automatically render the organization or individuals responsible ineligible for future use of the auditorium.
