

ORDINANCE NO. 907

An Ordinance Amending and Re-stating a Section of the Criminal Code of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED:

That Article 83 of the Criminal Code of the City of Slidell, Louisiana be amended and re-enacted as follows:

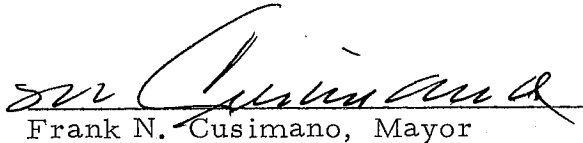
Article 83. Soliciting upon private residence.

The going in and upon private residences in this municipality by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants, and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise, and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor.

This article shall not apply to the activities in the normal course of affairs of the Junior Achievement of Southeast Louisiana, Inc., whose members are selling their own goods. The members of the Junior Achievement of Southeast Louisiana, Inc., shall be properly identified as such when soliciting and shall solicit and sale only until the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M.

Whoever violates the provision of this article shall be fined not more than One hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) dollars or shall be confined not more than thirty (30) days, or both.
