

ORDINANCE NO. 911

An Ordinance Creating an Air Conditioning and Heating Board for the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED:

That there shall hereby be established the Air Conditioning and Heating Board of the City.

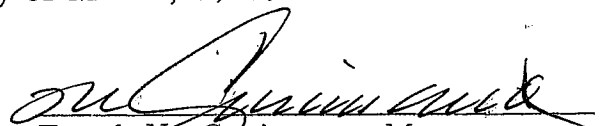
Said Air Conditioning and Heating Board shall consist of not more than five (5) persons appointed by the Mayor and City Council, who shall serve until replaced by the Mayor and City Council. Air Conditioning and Heating examinations will be prepared and presented to the Mayor and City Council for their approval. These examinations will be given to all applicants for air conditioning and heating licenses. The air conditioning and heating examination will consist of nationally recognized practices, procedures and standards in the industry and the experience of the applicant. The Board shall determine what is adequate for each particular applicant, but in no case shall the experience of the applicant be less than one (1) year.

A date shall be set by the Board, not more than ninety (90) days apart, on which an applicant may take the examination. The only exemption would be in the case where an individual would desire a temporary license for a particular job. In this case the individual would not have to take the examination if there is a working agreement between the City of Slidell and the City where this person is licensed.

Any applicant for an air conditioning and heating license shall be required to submit to the Board not less than five (5) working days before the examination date:

1. His resume of qualifications.
2. \$10.00 examination fee.
