

ORDINANCE NO. 914

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from The St. Tammany Parish Industrial District No. 1, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times, March 25th, April 1st and 8th, 1973, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened that:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

ALL THAT CERTAIN LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, situated in Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, all as more fully shown on a survey of J. V. Burkes, C.E., dated February 8, 1972, Survey No. 7714, and according to which survey measures as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 34, go North 89 degrees, 35 minutes West, 865.92 feet to the easterly Right-of-Way of G. M. & O. Railroad; thence go along said Right-of-way North 19 degrees, 54 minutes West, 1021.02 feet to the point of beginning.

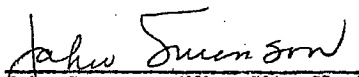
Thence from the point of beginning go South 82 degrees, 17 minutes, 28 seconds East, 770.96 feet to the West Right-of-Way of a 60 foot road; thence go along said Right-of-Way North 00 degrees, 10 minutes East, 554.76 feet to the Right-of-Way of Ben Thomas Road; thence go along said Right-of-Way in four courses, North 76 degrees, 50 minutes East, 209.41 feet; thence go South 88 degrees, 40 minutes West, 213.0 feet, thence go North 86 degrees, 20 minutes West, 340 feet (more or less), thence go South 70 degrees 58 minutes West, 190 feet (more or less), thence go South 70 degrees, 58 minutes West, 190 feet (more or less) to the easterly Right-of-Way of G. M. & O. Railroad. Thence go along said railroad Right-of-Way South 19 degrees, 54 minutes East, 484.07 feet back to the point of beginning.

Said parcel contains 10.91 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
