

ORDINANCE NO. 920

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from George Reine III, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries to include 9.65 acres; and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner was the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times, under dates of June 21st and 28th, July 5th, 1973, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to wit:

That certain piece or portion of ground, together with all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, advantages and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of section 34, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, go South 0 degrees 15' West 714.0 feet to an iron; thence West 710.8 feet to an iron; Thence North 19 degrees 15' East 756.4 feet to an iron; thence East 466.0 feet to an iron, which is the point of departure, and in all containing 9.65 acres of land, more or less.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
