

ORDINANCE NO. 929

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging its boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the Governing Body of said Municipality, did receive a petition from Miles O. Pollard, requesting the enlargement of the City boundaries and rezoning to C-4 Commercial, to include the following described property, and,

WHEREAS, the said Governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner was the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of said petition by publication in the Slidell - St. Tammany Times, under the dates of December 13, 20, 27, 1973, and January 3, 1974, and no one requested a public hearing, nor objected to said petition.

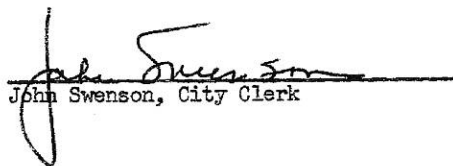
SECTION I: NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

West Expressway Shopping Center Subdivision 2ABC, 3ABC, 4ABC, 5ABC, 6ABC, 7ABC, 8ABC, 9ABC, 11ABC, 12ABC, 13ABC, 21ABC, 22ABC, 23ABC, 24ABC, 25ABC, 26ABC, 29ABC, 30ABC, 31ABC, 32ABC, 33ABC, 34ABC, as per J. J. Krebs and Sons, plat of survey dated April 28th, 1962.

SECTION II: THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all the above described property shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
