

ORDINANCE NO. 936

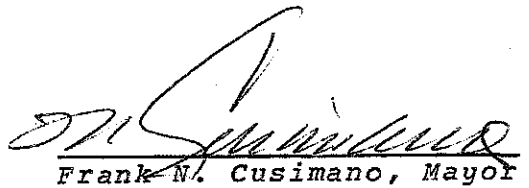
An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of fifty (50) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the City Hall Improvement and Jail and Courthouse Bonds of the City of Slidell, for the year 1974.

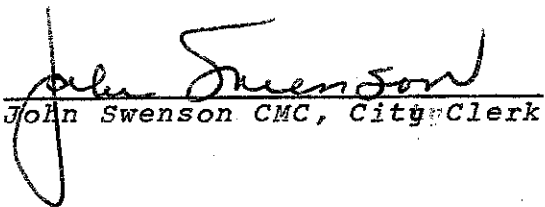
SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of fifty (50) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1973.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing Bonds of the City Hall Improvement and Jail and Courthouse Bonds for the City of Slidell for the year 1974, as duly authorized by Resolution 662 of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 6th day of August, 1962.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage.
