

ORDINANCE NO. 938

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. G. Harrison Scott, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times, March 24th - 31st and April 7th, 1974, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

A certain parcel of land situated in lot 5, section 3, Township 9 South, Range 14 East; St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest intersection of Gause Blvd. and Ninth Street right of ways, (R.O.W.), go North 0 degrees - 26' - 50" East 273.57 Feet; Thence South 89 degrees - 27' - 30" West 158.80 feet; Thence South 0 degrees - 26' - 50" East 283.89 Feet to a point on the North R.O.W. of Gause Blvd; Thence go North 89 degrees - 20' - 32" East along said R.O.W. 148.80 feet; Thence North 44 degrees - 27' - 23" East 14.16 feet to the point of beginning containing in all 1.03 acres of land more or less.

Said parcel contains 1.03 acres of land.

All in accordance with Survey No. 2012 dated February 15th, 1974, Revised February 21st, 1974, by Ivan Borgen, C.E.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and zoned C-2 Commercial.

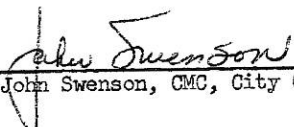
This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

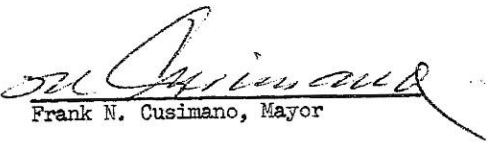
