

ORDINANCE NO. 943

An Ordinance adding Chapter 2, Article IV, to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, Establishing Departmental Review Boards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED:

Article IV. Employee Review Boards

Section 2-50. Police Review Board

A Police Review Board is hereby established which shall consist of five (5) members, to-wit: A private citizen appointed by the Mayor, the three-member Police Committee of the City Council, and a representative of the non-commissioned police officers, duly elected as such. The Chairman shall be chairman of the relevant Council committee. The Police Review Board shall meet once a quarter on the call of the chairman of its members after due notice to all other members, or on the request of an employee after consultation with the Department representative.

Section 2-51. Duties and Powers

It shall be the duty of the Police Review Board to study and recommend policies and actions to the Mayor and City Council concerning the Police Department in the following areas: public complaints, officer complaints, salaries, seniority, fringe benefits, a tenure system, sick leave, holidays, vacations, disciplinary policy, job qualifications and job classifications, etc. The Police Review Board shall report to the Mayor and City Council after each meeting.

Sections 2-52 - 2-59 Reserved.

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Section 2-60. Department of Public Works Review Boards

Department of Public Works Review Boards are hereby established and shall consist of five (5) members each, to-wit: A private citizen appointed by the Mayor, the three-member relevant City Council Committee, and a representative of non-management employees duly elected from each of the Sanitation, Water and Street Departments.

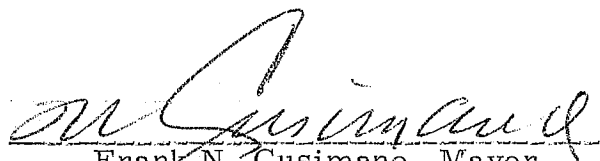
The Department of Public Works Review Boards shall meet once a quarter on the call of the chairman of its members after due notice to all other members, or at the request of an employee after consultation with the Department representative.

Section 2-61. Duties and Powers

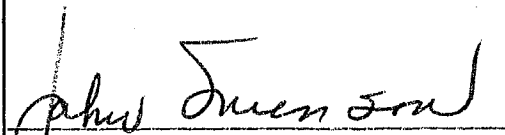
It shall be the duty of the Department of Public Works Review Boards to study and recommend policies and actions to the Mayor and City Council concerning the Department of Public Works in the following areas: employee complaints, salaries and wages, seniority, fringe benefits, a tenure system, sick leave, vacations, holidays, disciplinary policy, job qualifications, job classification, etc. The Department of Public Works Review Boards shall report to the Mayor and City Council after each meeting.
