

ORDINANCE NO. 945

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Dr. Carl A. Scarpelli, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, July 25th, August 1st and 8th, 1974, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From the Southwest corner of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 2, go East 1313.94 ft., thence go North 1160.6 ft., thence go N 38 degrees 16' W - 73.0 ft. to the point of beginning, thence 100 ft. S 49 degrees 22' W, thence 250 ft. N 38 degrees 16' W, thence 100 ft. N. 49 degrees 22' E, thence 250 ft. S 38 degrees 16' E to the point of beginning.

Said parcel contains 0.573 acres of land.

All in accordance with Survey No. 8729 dated April 5th, 1973, by J. V. Burkes, C.E.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and zoned C-2 Commercial.
