

ORDINANCE NO. 950

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from George Reine III, V. P. - Circle "R", Inc., requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, August 25th and 29th, September 5th, 1974, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From the section cor. common to sections 2, 3, 34 and 35 of said township and range go N.00 deg. 15 min. E. 1016.30 feet to the point of beginning. Thence continue N.00 deg. 15 min. E. 1677.42 feet to an iron; Thence N. 89 deg. 58 min. E. 2642.89 feet to an iron; Thence S.00 deg. 26 min. N. 1360.0 feet to an iron; Thence S.00 deg. 02 min. E. 171.50 feet to an iron; Thence N.89 deg. 58 min. N. 1805.10 feet to an iron; Thence S.00 deg. 02 min. W. 147.8 feet to an iron; Thence S.89 deg. 57 min. W. 834.80 feet to the point of departure; containing 95.582 acres of land more or less.

Said parcel contains 95.582 acres of land to be known as Brookwood Estates.

All in accordance with Survey No. 1958 dated January 29th, 1974, by Ivan Borgen, C.E.

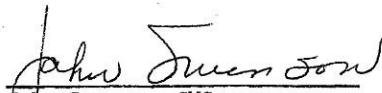
SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and zoned A-6 Residential.

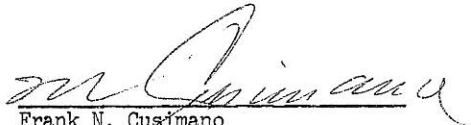
This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
