

ORDINANCE 952

An Ordinance to amend and restate and re-enact Sections 7-3 and 7-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, establishing guidelines for the Electrical Code and the Licensing of Electricians.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED:

Sec. 7-3. Electrical code adopted.

The National Electrical Code, published by the National Bureau of Fire Underwriters, is hereby adopted as the electrical code of the city. (Ord. No. 679-1, §2, 4-2-63)

Sec. 7-4. Licensing of electricians.

(a) The electrical control board of the city consists of the city electrical inspector and five (5) persons appointed by the mayor and city council, who shall serve until replaced by the mayor and city council.

(b) Electrical examinations will be prepared and presented to the mayor and city council for their approval. These examinations will be given to all applicants for electrical contractor's licenses.

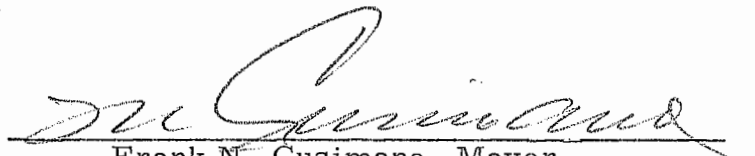
(c) The electrical examination will consist of the national electrical code and the experience of the applicant. The board shall determine what is adequate for each particular applicant, but in no case shall the experience of the applicant be less than one year.

(d) A date shall be set by the board, not more than ninety (90) days apart, on which an applicant may take the examination. The only exemption would be in the case where an individual would desire a temporary license for a particular job. In this case the individual would not have to take the examination if there is a working agreement between the City of Slidell and the city where this person is licensed.

(e) Any applicant for an electrical license shall be required to submit to the city not less than fifteen (15) working days before the examination date:

- (1) His journeyman wireman qualifications (minimum one-year experience).
- (2) Ten dollars (\$10.00) examination fee.
