

ORDINANCE NO. 974

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. George Reine III, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the said governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, June 5th, 12th and 19th, 1975, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

A certain parcel of land situated in Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more fully described as follows: From the Southeast Corner of said Section 35, go North 89 degrees 51' West 1,322.3 feet to an iron and the point of beginning. Thence continue North 89 degrees 51' West 661.15 feet to an iron; thence North 1,344.68 feet to an iron; thence North 89 degrees 57' East 662.03 feet to an iron; thence South 0 degrees 02' West 1,346.9 feet to the point of departure, MOB Folio

Said parcel contains 20.44 acres of land and is to be known as Forest Manor East Subdivision

All in accordance with Survey No. 636 dated June 13th, 1973, by Ivan Borgen, C.E.

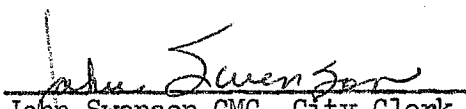
SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
